How Organizations Can Support the Clean Energy & Jobs Oakland Campaign

The goal of this campaign is to establish, in conjunction with other East Bay cities, a Community Choice energy program for Oakland that provides community benefits to residents of our city. Please support this effort. Here's what your organization can do:

1. Immediately: Sign the call.

We call on Oakland City Council to support development by East Bay MUD of a Community Choice energy program that includes Oakland.

A Community Choice energy program lets the community decide where its electricity comes from. That means we can build local renewable energy resources. Doing so would provide local economic development, clean energy jobs, lower utility bills, stable prices, cleaner air, and other community benefits, while reducing local greenhouse gas emissions (as called for in the Oakland Energy and Climate Action Plan).
