



### EC Bay Area –San Francisco Mission Housing Development Corporation



- Pilot: 4 buildings
- •700k ARRA Stimulus Grant
- •CWA agreement: local hire target
  - •8 Journey level and 2 apprenticeship jobs (6 SF)
  - •Upgrade energy related infrastructure, reduce operations costs
  - Engaged Community Partners as Stakeholders



- •20 buildings, 1000 units, approximately \$5-8million
- •Innovative Financing with Bronze Energy and **Investments** 
  - Lighting, Water, HVAC & Solar
- •BAYREN MF Housing Rebates of \$750 per unit
- Leverage CWA for job access and local hire




